7	WHEREAS, the Flood Control Zone District ("District") Board of Supervisors
8	passed Motion FCD11-02 on July 11, 2011, authorizing the District to work in
9	collaboration with Green River valley cities in meeting Federal Emergency Management
10	Agency ("FEMA") certification standards of levee segments and to assume operation,
11	maintenance and repair responsibilities necessary for certification of levee segments,
12	when the levees are designed and constructed consistent with King County Flood Hazard
13	Management Plan Policy PROJ-6, Flood Protection Facility Design and Maintenance
14	Objectives; and
15	WHEREAS, Resolution FCD2011-16 approved the Agreement for Levee
16	Construction, Operation and Maintenance ("Agreement") between the District and the
17	city of Kent, which sets forth specific technical requirements to be achieved to ensure
18	that levee improvements are constructed consistent with flood risk policies in the adopted
19	King County Flood Hazard Management Plan; and

20	WHEREAS, Resolutions FCD2008-17 and FCD2010-41.2 designate King
21	County, through the Water and Land Resources Division of the King County Department
22	of Natural Resources and Parks (WLRD), as the District's service provider; and
23	WHEREAS, the director of WLRD has the expertise to evaluate the technical
24	requirements and performance measures necessary to ensure the District's objectives are
25	achieved; now, therefore
26	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE KING
27	COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT:
28	SECTION 1. On behalf of the District, the King County executive, or his
29	designee, is authorized to (a) approve the levee operation plan and manual under the
30	Agreement and (b) approve and sign any other documents related to the City of Kent's

- FEMA levee certification applications, as long as such documents are consistent with the
- 32 Agreement.
