DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal – This threshold determination analyzes the environmental impacts associated with the following actions, which are so closely related to each other that they are in effect a single course of action:

- 1. Adoption of the 2013-2019 Highline School District Capital Facilities Plan by the Highline School District for the purposes of planning for the facilities needs of the District;
- 2. The amendment of the King County Comprehensive Plan to include the Highline School District's 2013 Capital Facilities Plan as part of the Capital Facilities Element of the King County Comprehensive Plan; and
- 3. The potential amendment of the Comprehensive Plans of the cities of Burien, SeaTac, Normandy Park, Des Moines, Tukwila and Kent to include the Highline School District's 2013 Capital Facilities Plan as part of the Capital Facilities Element of each jurisdiction's Comprehensive Plan.

Proponent - Highline School District No. 401

Location of proposal: The Highline School District includes an area of approximately 27 square miles (excluding SeaTac Airport). The cities of Burien, SeaTac, Normandy Park, Des Moines, Tukwila and Kent and parts of unincorporated King County fall within the District's boundaries.

Lead agency – Highline School District No. 401

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.

This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2); the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the date of issue. Comments must be submitted by 4:30 pm June 19, 2013. The responsible official will reconsider the DNS based on timely comments and may retain, modify, or, if significant adverse impacts are likely, withdraw the DNS. If the DNS is retained, it will be final after the expiration of the comment deadline.
