The board remanded to the County the KCCP's Introduction, Chapters 1 and 2, and Technical Appen-diatory amongene to the GMA, includ-ing statutory amendments effective after 2008. On September 17, 2013, the Council's Transportation, Economy and Environ-ment Committee completed its review of the sublect legislation which makes re-visions to the remanded portions of the KCCP did the dise or the KCCP comples with the GMA and reported it out to the Council with a "do pass" recommendation.
