The 2014-2019 CIP for annual budgets calls for capitol outlays of about \$154.2 million over the next six years. Of that budget authority, approximately \$151 million is assumed for expenditure in 2014, with \$143 million for general government capital programs and \$7.6 million for maintenance projects.

tenance proiects.
Biennial, two-year budgets for 2013/2014 are as fallows: \$451.8 million is for the Wastewater Treatment capital program, \$25 million for Surface Water Management facilities, \$101.2 million for Solid Waste facilities, \$70.6 million for Roads and \$454.3 million for other biennial capital proiects.

The Capital Improvement Program Budget is divided into three program categories that reflect the goals of the King County Strategic Plan:

- County Strategic Plan:

  1 The Economic Growth and Built Environment Area encompasses economic development, transportation, planning and permitting, trails, and rural activities and services. This category supports the International Airport, road services, transit, park facilities and housing programs.

  2 The Environmental Sustainability Area includes pragrams for safeguarding and enhancing the county's natural resources and environment. This category includes wastewater treatment, salid waste, flood and surface water, and open space acquisition.

  3 The General Government Area reflects
- 3 The General Government Area reflects how the county provides services to the public. These services include lease costs for county agencies, facility capital improvements, Horborview Medical Center and technology improvements for King County agencies.
