

Adds a new low income transit fare tor eligible customers with incomes at or below 200 percent at the Federal Poverty Level. This new low income transit fare will be set at a flat rate of \$1.50 per trip and will not vary by time at day or distance traveled. Low income customers must provide proof at income eligibility in order to obtain a regional smart card (ORCA) which is required for fare payment. The low income fare will take effect Morch 1, 2015, only if the County Council approves a low income program implementation plan by mation, prior to December 31, 2014.
