



# Skykomish Valley

- Private working forests




## Skykomish Valley - King County

### Land Conservation Targets

- King County acquisition of riparian habitat, floodplain and river access
- Forest Service acquisition of key inholdings of old-growth forest and existing roadless areas

### Existing & Potential Recreational Facilities

- Stevens Pass Ski Area & Mountain Bike Center
- Iron Goat Trail & Wellington (historic railroad grade & town site), Alpine Lakes Wilderness Trails, Beckler Peak Bicycle Trail (under construction)
- Proposed trails from town of Skykomish to Sobieski Mountain and vista point on Maloney Rock
- New river access, e.g. Foss River, Skykomish

- Trails (existing - green; proposed - purple)
- River reaches used by boaters (blue)
- Existing and potential river access points
