### Summary:

Proposed amendments would:

- · Amend development conditions (VS-P29 and VS-P30) to allow submittal of applications for recreational marijuana business and wineries, breweries and distilleries on commercial or industrial zoned lands located within the Town Center of Vashon Island, and
- Approve a Four-to-One development proposal on RAzoned land to the southwest of the City of Maple Valley.
