**Title: Check Processing Equipment, Software and DOL Mainframe System Integration**

**Requesting Agency: RECORDS AND LICENSNG SERV. (EN\_A47000)**

A new check endorsement machine was acquired in 2012, however the remaining check handling equipment, software, and Department of Licensing (DOL) mainframe integration was not completed by year's end. This project was delayed pending working through the details and receiving DOL direction and approval. RALS continues to work with DOL in an effort to implement the new equipment and complete the software integration.
