Sponsors

1 A RESOLUTION relating to the operations and finances of
2 the King County Flood Control Zone District; adopting a
3 revised 2014 budget and operating budget; and amending
4 sections 1 and 2 of Resolution FCD2014-08.

5 WHEREAS, the King County Flood Control Zone District ("District") adopted
6 the 2014 work program, budget, operating budget (for King County), capital budget, six-
7 year capital improvement program, oversight budget and subregional opportunity fund
8 allocations in Resolution FCD2013-014.3; and

9 WHEREAS, by Resolution FCD2014-08, the District adopted amendments to
10 Resolution FCD2013-014.3; and

11 WHEREAS, the District and the King County Water and Land Resources
12 Division ("WLRD") considered and evaluated the Division's contract oversight, site
13 inspection and maintenance, and grant application services, and concluded that adding
14 four and one-half full time equivalent employees to WLRD's staff will facilitate proper
15 oversight of contracts, provide an appropriate level of site inspection and maintenance,
16 and allow for filing of more grant applications; and

17 WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 86.15.140, the District held a public hearing on the
18 budget items proposed in this Resolution on July 21, 2014; now, therefore

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE KING
20 COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT:

21 SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors amends Attachment B, adopted by
22 section 2 of Resolution FCD2013-14.3 and amended by section 1 of Resolution
23 FCD2014-08, by replacing it with the "2014 Revised Budget 7-9-14," Attachment A to
24 this Resolution.

25 SECTION 2. The Board of Supervisors amends Attachment C, adopted by
26 section 3 of Resolution FCD2013-14.3 and amended by section 2 of Resolution

- 27 FCD2014-08, by replacing it with the "2014 Revised Operating Budget 7-9-14",

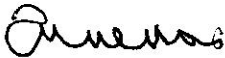
