SUMMARY
The proposed ordinance identifies temporary homeless encompments as interim survival mechanisms that are part of the county-wide strategy of ending homelessness. The proposed ordinance will extend king County's existing regulations related to temporary homeless encompments through January 1, 2025.

The proposed ordinance will add provisions related to public notice and enforcement of health and safety violations, and will extend the length of time an encompment can be located at a single site.
