NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courtbouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 10th day of November 10, 2014, of 11:00 a.m., to consider adoption of Praposed Ordinance 2014-0408, assuming governance of the King County ferry district.

Proposed Ordinance 2014-0408 provides in part:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Findings:

A. On [BATE], the King County council held the public hearing as required by Ordinance 1798s and RCW 36.150.202.

B. After that public hearing council determines that the public interest or welfare would be satisfied by the county assuming the rights, powers, immunities, functions and obligations of the King County terry district and hereby declares that to be the council's Intent.

SECTION 2. King County hereby assumes

SECTION 2. King County hereby assumes oil rights, powers, immunities, functions and obligations of the King County ferry district as set forth in chapter 36.54 RCW and the same are hereby vested in accordance with the executive and legislative responsibilities defined in the King County Charter. The county is now vested with all the rights, powers, immunities, functions and obligations formerly vested by low in the governing board of the King County ferry district. In exercising such rights, powers, immunities, functions and obligations, all actions will be taken in the name of the county. Title to all ferry district property or property rights is vested in the county.

SECTION 3. As required by RCW 36.150.40(2), the terry district board is hereby abolished.
