

### METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 17th day of November, 2014, at 11:00 a.m., pursuant to RCW 89.08.400 and .405, to consider a system of rates and charges proposed by the King Conservation District (KCD) for the years 2015-2019 ("the KCD proposal") in conjunction with the public hearing on Proposed Ordinance 2014-0437 which would set the system of rates and charges for the KCD and their duration.

#### SUMMARY

The KCD proposal requests that the Metropolitan King County Council consider and approve a natural resource conservation system of rates and charges for the King Conservation District in the following amounts: agricultural lands, ten dollars per parcel per year; residential lands, nine dollars and forty-five cents per parcel per year; institutional or public lands, nine dollars and twenty-five cents per parcel per year; commercial lands, nine dollars and twenty-three cents per parcel per year; open space lands, eight dollars and ninety-three cents per parcel per year; vacant or undeveloped lands, seven dollars and seventy cents per parcel per year; and forested lands, zero dollars and zero cents per parcel per year; with the following lands exempted from such charges: lands owned by federally recognized Native American tribes or members of such tribes that are located within the historical boundaries of a reservation.

The KCD proposal provides that the use of revenues from the system of rates and charges would be to implement a proposed program of work and budget.
