#### **FD Resolution**

	Proposed No. FD2014-12.1 Sponsors
1	A RESOLUTION supporting King County's approval and
2	execution of an agreement with the Washington State Department
3	of Transportation to waive indirect costs for the design and
4	construction of the Seattle Multimodal Terminal, including the
5	new Passenger-Only Ferry Terminal.
6	WHEREAS, the King County Ferry District ("District") operates a passenger-only
7	ferry terminal ("POF Terminal") at Pier 50 in Seattle, Washington, pursuant to the
8	Terminal License Agreement No. GCA 6750, dated August 18, 2011, between the
9	District and the Washington State Department of Transportation Ferries Division
10	("WSF"); and
11	WHEREAS, WSF plans to replace the Seattle Ferry Terminal at Piers 50 and 52
12	(Colman Dock) with a Seattle Multimodal Terminal, which will require removal of the
13	current POF Terminal; and
14	WHEREAS, at the District's request, WSF has agreed to include the new POF
15	Terminal in the design of the Seattle Multimodal Terminal; and
16	WHEREAS, WSF policies provide for WSF to charge the District for its indirect
17	costs relating to the design of the new POF Terminal at the Seattle Multimodal Terminal;
18	and

19	WHEREAS, RCW 47.28.260 authorizes public agencies and municipal
20	corporations to waive indirect costs related to a project or work that will be performed by
21	one party for the other party's benefit; and
22	WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Transportation ("WSDOT")
23	and King County have negotiated an agreement to waive indirect costs relating to the
24	Seattle Multimodal Terminal, including the new POF Terminal, titled "Reciprocal
25	Agreement between Washington State Department of Transportation and King County,
26	Department of Transportation for Mutual Waiver of Indirect Costs (Agreement GCB
27	1926)" ("Mutual Waiver Agreement"); and
28	WHEREAS, although the District is not a party to the Mutual Waiver Agreement
29	the District is a beneficiary of the Mutual Waiver Agreement, which would waive
30	indirect costs relating to the design and construction of the Seattle Multimodal Terminal,
31	including the POF Terminal; and
32	WHEREAS, the District desires to express its support for King County's
33	execution of the Mutual Waiver Agreement; now, therefore
34	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE KING
35	COUNTY FERRY DISTRICT:
36	SECTION 1. The board of supervisors supports King County's approval and
37	execution of an agreement between King County and WSDOT relating to waiver of
38	indirect costs pursuant to RCW 47.28.260, substantially in the form of "Reciprocal
