Name of Proposal: Ordinance 2015-0169 extending King County's moratorium on Marijuana Collective Gardens and Dispensaries

Description of Proposal: An ordinance renewing for six-months an existing moratorium on the establishment or location of medical marijuana dispensaries and collective gardens asserted to be or actually authorized under Chapter 181, Laws of Washington 2011, and chapter 69.51A RCW. The moratorium would prohibit permitting or operation of any medical marijuana collective gardens or dispensaries, in unincorporated King County, for six months.
