6	contained a proviso in Section 129, which stated that three hundred thousand dollars
7	could not be encumbered or expended until the executive transmitted a Ravensdale
8	project status report and a motion that approves the report and the motion was passed by
9	the council, and
10	WHEREAS, the parks and recreation division of the department of natural
11	resources and parks, with participation of the Ravensdale Park Foundation, reviewed
12	issues identified in the expansion of the project, and
13	WHEREAS, based on that review, the parks and recreation division developed a
14	status report addressing the expansion of the project scope and requirements of Ordinance
15	17941, and
16	WHEREAS, the review and analysis resulted in a mutually agreed-upon solution
17	between Ravensdale Park Foundation and the parks and recreation division to amend the
18	use agreement and address the funding balance with a combination of fee grace periods,
19	community fundraising and additional funding from the division, and

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WHEREAS, the executive has transmitted to the council the requested report and 20 motion;

## Ravensdale Project Status Report - April 2015

The Ravensdale Park Master Plan was adopted by the community in 2009. The Master Plan outlined several phases to complete the plan. The project is being implemented through the Community Partnerships and Grants Program (CPG). The community partner is the Ravensdale Park Foundation, whose members include youth soccer, youth baseball, youth lacrosse, youth football, and the community at large.

Phase 1 of the plan included the installation of a synthetic soccer field and a synthetic baseball infield, it was completed in 2011.

Phase 2 includes the planning, designing, permitting, and construction of 2 large multi-use synthetic fields with lights, 154 car parking lot, new restroom and concession stand, maintenance building, utilities, stormwater and treatment systems, widening of Kent Kangley Road, and all related infrastructure. The project has reached substantial completion. A final punchlist walkthrough will occur on Tuesday May 19. Some items will continue throughout the year including peripheral landscaping and small finishing touches. The maintenance building will be constructed by the community over the summer.

The current amount of funds needed for the project from King County to cover the expanded project scope and additional costs is \$279,128. Additional costs are being covered by the Ravensdale Park Foundation through its contingency budget and additional fundraising.

This status report is provided in response to Ordinance 17941, Section 129, Proviso P7. Outlined below is the details of project status to date:
