The county assessor of King County has certified to the 4 metropolitan King County council that the assessed valuation of the County of King as 5 finally equalized amounts to \$423,509,867,430. 6 SECTION 2. The metropolitan King County council imposes the levies necessary 7 to fund estimated expenditures for the year 2016 as listed in this section. These amounts 8 do not include the total of estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including 9 available surplus and such expenditures as are to be net from bond warrant issues. In 10

11 accordance with state law, the King County assessor calculated a sum for property taxes

12 available to the county related to new construction, improvements to property, refunds

13 and any increase in the assessed value of state assessed property. In calculating the
