Ordinance 18184
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council held a public hearing in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (516 Third Avenue, Seattle Washington) on Monday, the 23rd day of November, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2015-0437 (Ordinance 18184), relating to the development of a regional motor sports facility demonstration project.
SUMMARY
Ordinance 18184 modifies the existing demonstration project ordinance, to allow for construction of 400,000 square feet of buildings, and grading necessary to construct the buildings, before going through the master planning demonstration project. These activities would be subject to an interim use permit, with a recommendation by the Department of Permitting of Environmental Review (DPER), and a public hearing and decision by the Hearing Examiner. The ordinance sets out submittal requirements, review criteria, and a timeline for DPER and the Hearing Examiner to process the interim use permit.
