1	AN ORDINANCE revising the legal description of the
2	annexation of approximately 0.29 acres of land into fire
3	district 27, known as Harkleroad Annexation, for the
4	purpose of providing fire suppression and emergency
5	medical services; and repealing Ordinance 18042, Section
6	1, as amended, Ordinance 18042, Section 2, Ordinance
7	18042, Section 3, and Ordinance 18042, Section 4.
8	STATEMENT OF FACTS:
9	1. Ordinance 18042, which approved the annexation of approximately
10	0.29 acres of land into fire district 27, was adopted by the council on May
11	18, 2015, and approved by the executive on May 27, 2015.
12	2. Because the legal description contained in Ordinance 18042 was later
13	deemed incorrect, Ordinance 18065, with a revised legal description, was
14	adopted by the council on June 15, 2015, and approved by the executive
15	on June 25, 2015.
16	3. After Ordinance 18065 was enacted it was determined that the revised
17	legal description of the annexation area was also incorrect.
18	4. On October 21, 2015, a Notice of Intention was filed with the
19	Washington state Boundary Review Board for King County

20	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
21	SECTION 1. The annexation of approximately 0.29 acres of land
22	into fire district 27, known as Harkleroad Annexation, for the purpose of
23	providing fire suppression and emergency medical services described in
24	Attachment A to this ordinance is approved. Approval of this proposed
25	annexation is consistent with chapter 52.04 RCW.
26	SECTION 2. Fire district 27 is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed
27	to be annexed.
28	SECTION 3. The county council finds that the property owners of the annexation
29	area are obligated to assume responsibility for any preexisting finances or indebtedness of
30	the district.
31	SECTION 4. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval
32	or disapproval of any other permits, certifications or actions necessary to provide service
33	to this annexation area.
34	SECTION 5. The following are each hereby repealed:
35	A. Ordinance 18042, Section 1, as amended;
36	B. Ordinance 18042, Section 2;

D. Ordinance 18042, Section 4.
