26	qualify it for funding under the parameters set forth in D.1. of this ordinance.
27	E. The duties of the communities of opportunitiy interim governance group are:
28	1. To make recommendations to the King County executive concerning the

- 49 4. Require that the successor group membership reflects the diversity in King County and that the successor group recognizes that strategies may vary for different 50 populations and in different locations of the county where there are inequitable health and 51 52 well-being outcomes."
- EFFECT: Adds positions for two community representatives and requires transmittal 53 of these appointments by February 15, 2016, requires that appointments to the 54 successor group seek to include community appointees (2 persons, or twenty percent of 55 the total number, whichever is greater).
