1 A MOTION expressing interest in the MV Spirit of
2 Kingston.

3 WHEREAS, the King County Ferry District ("District") operates two waterborne
4 public transportation routes using two leased vessels and maintaining multiple
5 agreements for back-up vessels as available at the time of need, and

6 WHEREAS, the District is constructing two new two hundred fifty passenger
7 vessels to replace the leased vessels and accommodate its growth and the long term
8 operation of waterborne public transportation services in King County, and

9 WHEREAS, the addition of a third vessel, with minimal initial capital cost to the
10 District, would support the public transportation operations of the District through
11 increased service and operational reliability, and

12 WHEREAS, the Port of Kingston has recently discontinued passenger only ferry
13 services and expressed that the MV Spirit of Kingston is surplus to their needs, and

14 WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration, which funded the acquisition of
15 the MV Spirit of Kingston, desires to keep the vessel in public transportation service;

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Board of Supervisors of the King
17 County Ferry District:

18 A. The King County Ferry District is interested in acquiring and using the MV
19 Spirit of Kingston to support its ongoing waterborne public transportation services; and

20 B. The chair of the board of supervisors is authorized to send a letter expressing
21 this interest to the Port of Kingston and the Federal Transit Administration, Region X,
22 and to plan for the integration of this vessel into the operations and services of the King
23 County Ferry District.




