2 pamphlet statements for the November 8, 2016, general
3 election regarding Ordinance 18308, which provides for the
4 submission to the qualified electors of King County at a
5 general election to be held in King County on November 8,
6 2016, of a proposition to make the office of King County
7 prosecuting attorney nonpartisan; amending Section 610 of
8 the King County Charter; adding a new Section 649 to the
9 King County Charter; and amending Section 680.10 of the
10 King County Charter.

11 WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of
12 local voters' pamphlets in conformity with chapter 29A.32 RCW for annual general
13 elections held in King County, and


14 WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides that, for each measure from a unit of
15 local government that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of
16 that jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating

18 rejection of the measure, and
