NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (S16 Third Avenue, Seattie, WA) on Monday, July 25, 2016, beginning at 1:30 PM. Ordinance 18326 amends the regulations pertaining to the County's zoning regulations for marijuana producers, processors and retailers.
