



# Ballot Drop Box Update King County Elections

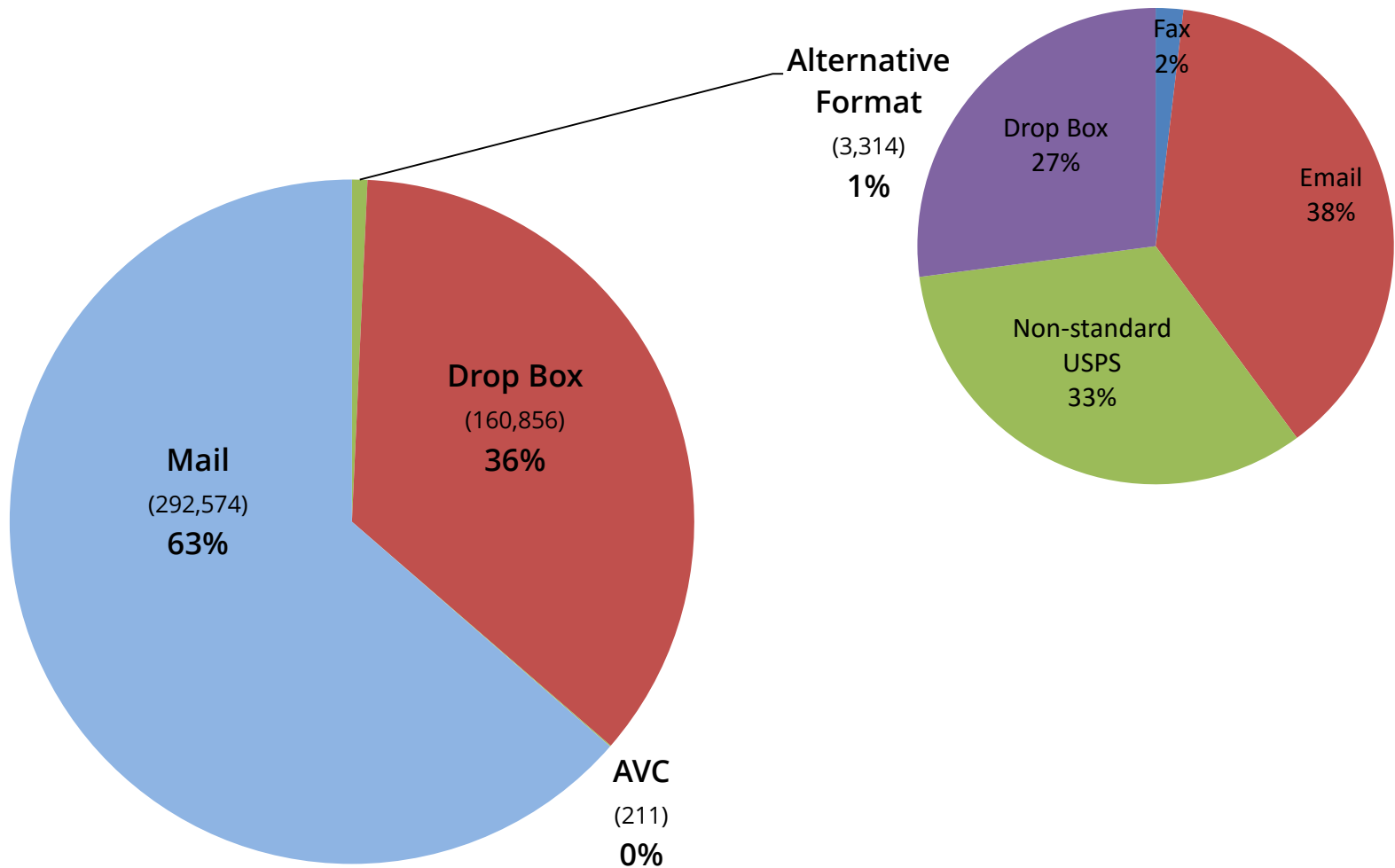


# Overview

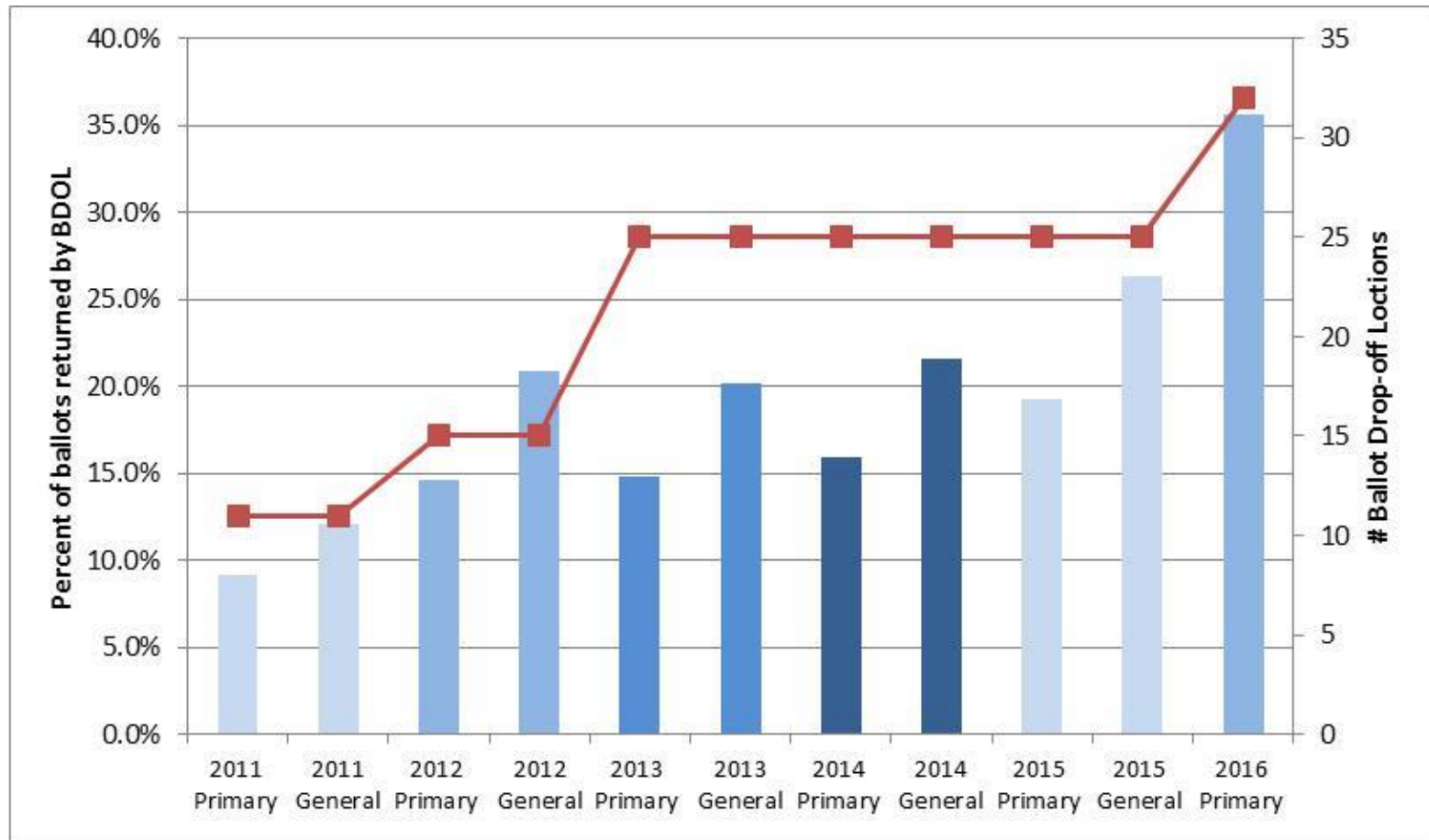
- 29 boxes – open between July 14<sup>th</sup> and August 2<sup>nd</sup>. Ten existing permanent boxes and 19 new ones.
- Nearly 36% of ballots were returned via drop-box. More than any election in recent history. Previously the highest percentage of ballots returned via drop-box was the 2015 General Election with 26.3%.
- More than 100,000 ballots were returned to drop boxes just on Election Day. That's 10,000 more than we've ever had returned in a single day.



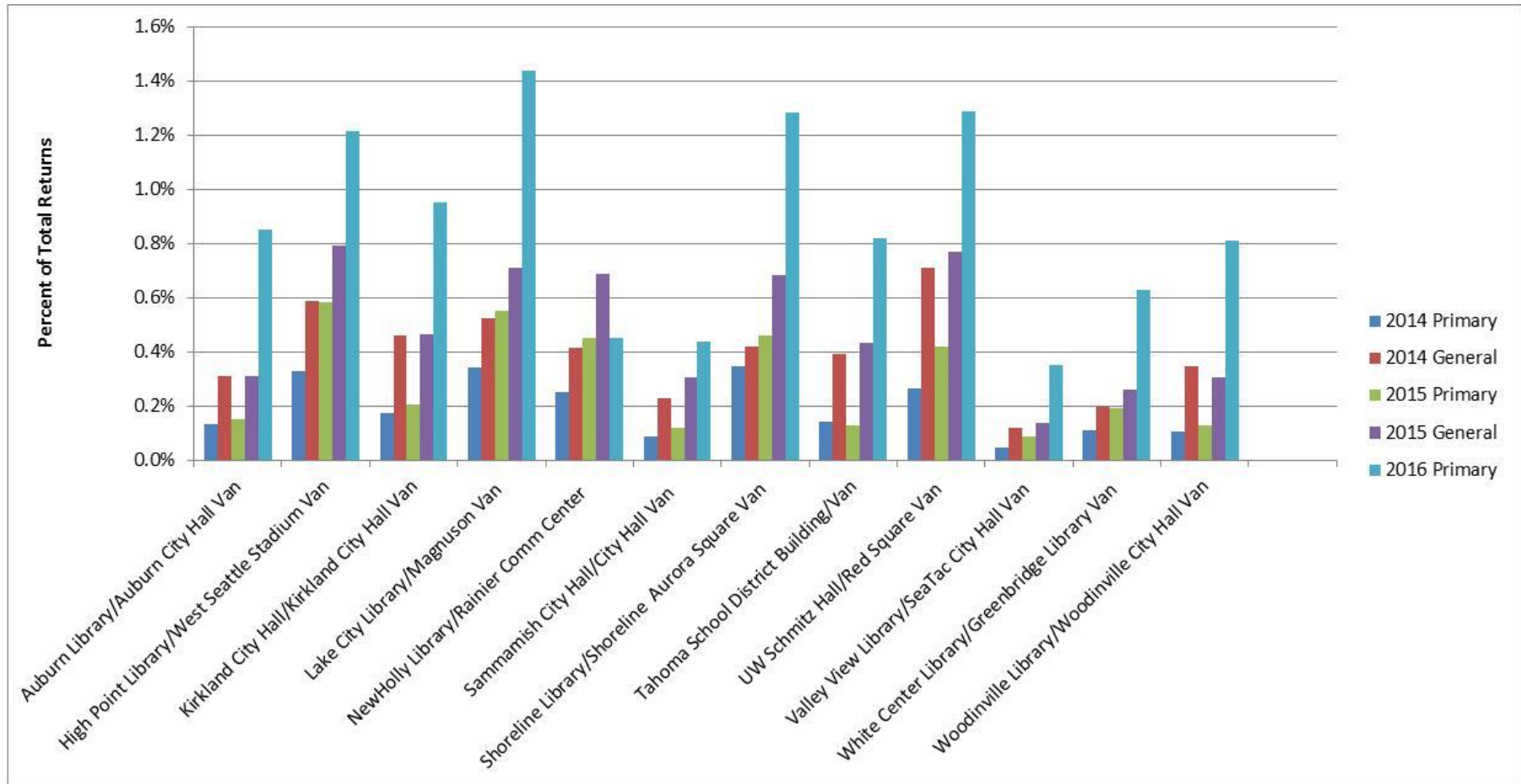
# Ballot Returns Overall



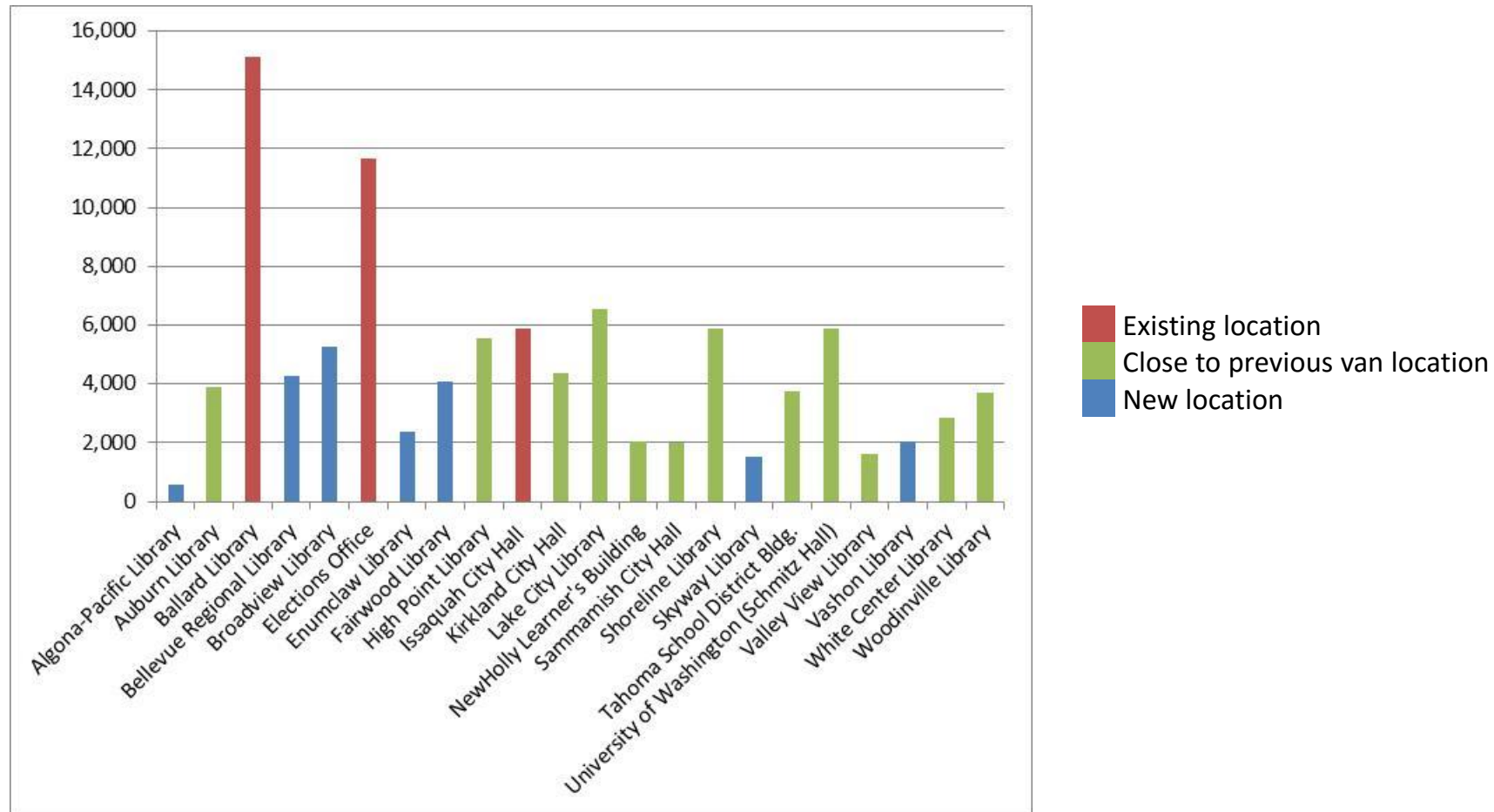
# Highest percent of ballots returned to drop boxes ever
