1	A Motion authorizing the executive director to proceed with writing and
2	issuing a request for proposal to hire a consultant to prepare a SEPA
3	programmatic environmental impact statement for the Lower Green River
4	Corridor Plan.
5	WHEREAS, the King County Flood Control Zone District ("District") is
6	embarking on corridor planning for approximately twenty-one river miles of the lower
7	Green River affecting the cities of Auburn, Kent, Tukwila and Renton as well as
8	unincorporated King County; and
9	WHEREAS, the lower Green River study area includes flood risk reduction
10	facilities in multiple jurisdictional ownerships and is surrounded by mixed land uses,
11	including commercial, residential, industrial, recreational and agricultural; and
12	WHEREAS, the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe has identified river water temperature
13	lack of shade, and lack of juvenile rearing habitat, as significant risks to fish populations
14	that are protected by the Endangered Species Act; and
15	WHEREAS, Water Resource Inventory Area 9 is responsible for planning related
16	to improving salmon habitat in the lower Green River; and
17	WHEREAS, the Lower Green River Corridor Plan ("LGRCP") is a follow-up
18	plan to the Interim System-Wide Improvement Framework ("Interim SWIF") submitted
19	to the United States Army Corps of Engineers for acceptance in February 2016; and

20	WHEREAS, the Interim SWIF was written to maintain eligibility for flood
21	damage repairs under the federal PL 84-99 Program, but did not address multiple
22	objectives; and
23	WHEREAS, the District desires to prepare a SEPA programmatic environmental
24	impact statement ("EIS") to establish a shared vision and goals for the lower Green River
25	corridor related to flood risk reduction, habitat, recreation, agriculture, and other values
26	that may be developed in open collaboration with stakeholders; develop a coordinated se
27	of performance and development guidelines and standards to implement the vision and
28	goals; identify alternatives for improvements that together can help achieve the plan's
29	vision and goals; and institute programmatic agreements or batched permitting processes
30	to aid in efficient regulatory review of planned capital improvements; and
31	WHEREAS, the LGRCP will draw on technical work already completed for the
32	Interim SWIF; and
33	WHEREAS, when complete, the LGRCP shall be formally adopted by the District;
34	and
35	WHEREAS, when adopted by the District, the LGRCP shall be incorporated into the
36	District Flood Hazard management Plan; and
37	WHEREAS, the District would like to move the Lower Russell Road levee setback
38	project forward through the EIS review process by incorporating a project-level review
39	within the SEPA programmatic EIS, which will be a subject for discussion with partners
40	and stakeholders during the scoping and environmental process; and
11	WHEREAS, the District has included funding for the SEPA programmatic EIS
12	through Resolution No. FCD 2016-10; and

43	WHEREAS, the District executive committee shall approve the selected EIS
14	consultant and the resulting contract shall be approved by the board of supervisors; and
45	WHEREAS, the selected firm will report to the District's project manager and will be
46	required to work collaboratively with the District's service provider, the King County
17	water and land resources division; now, therefore,
