- "11. According to executive reporting, through the 2016 paid parental 3

- leave hours in the first half of 2016. Of the one hundred twenty 5
- employees, seventy-three were male and forty-seven were female, which 6
- 7 is consistent with the gender breakdown of King County's workforce. The
- 8 costs of the program through June 30, 2016, were consistent with the
- 9 estimated costs for 2016.
- 12. Based on the success of King County's pilot program, establishing an 10
- 11 ongoing paid parental leave program is in the best interest of King County
- 12 employees, their families and the public that the employees serve.
- 13. For employees who experienced a qualifying event in 2016 but were 13
- adversely affected by being ineligible to participate in the 2016 paid 14
- 15 parental leave pilot program, the executive is encouraged to seek and
- implement mitigation options as this ongoing paid parental leave program 16
- 17 is implemented."

19	"B. The executive is authorized to enter into memoranda of agreement with the
20	labor organizations that represent King County employees to provide those employees
21	paid parental leave consistent with the terms of this section."

23	EFFECT: Adds statement of fact about success of Paid Parental Leave pilot program,
24	and encourages Executive to implement mitigation options for those who were
25	previously unable to participate. Additionally, it authorizes the Executive to enter into
26	memoranda of agreement to implement this ordinance.
