1	A MOTION calling on Congress to swiftly and	
2	comprehensively address federal immigration reform	
3	generally and Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals in	
4	particular to protect the legal status of thousands of	
5	Dreamers.	
6	WHEREAS, Motion 14851 established King County's Federal Legislative	
7	Agenda, including a call for immigration reform, and	
8	WHEREAS, an estimated 800,000 United States residents, who came to the	
9	United States as children, have benefitted from the protections afforded by the Deferred	
10	Action for Childhood Arrivals ("DACA") program, allowing them to lead productive	
11	lives with reduced fear relating to their immigration status, and	
12	WHEREAS, the announcement today by United States Attorney General Jeff	
13	Sessions that the administration will end the DACA program in six months has brought	
14	new and increased urgency to this legislative priority, and	
15	WHEREAS, congressional action on DACA is imperative given the six month	
16	window before the program is terminated.	
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:	
18	A. The metropolitan King County council:	
19	1. Expresses King County's strong support for continuing the protections

20 afforded under the DACA program; 2. Calls on congress to swiftly and comprehensively address federal 21 immigration reform generally and DACA in particular to protect the legal status of 22 23 thousands of Dreamers; 3. Directs the county's federal legislative team to prioritize work during the next 24 six months to support efforts in Congress to continue the DACA protections; and 25 4. Requests that King County's government affairs teams commence efforts to 26 build a broad coalition of county officials nationwide to support efforts in Congress to 27 sustain the protections afforded by DACA. 28
