

- 7 with cities are in place at the time of capital bond issuance.

- 4 "Lines 47-51 in the Statement of Facts should be amended as follows:
- 5 "10. If Bellevue extends its interlocal agreement and the Houghton transfer station is
- 7 close in accordance with earlier plans, the county's transfer system would might exceed
- 8 level-of-service standards without a Northeast station and demand management at the
- 9 Factoria transfer and recycling station would may no longer be a substitute for a
- 10 Northeast station".
- 12 Amended language does not make a statement of fact that presumes that demand
- management strategies would not be successful in managing transfer station
- 14 transactions.
