March 2018 Service Change Proposal

The proposed March 2018 Service Change Ordinance includes proposals for:

- Target Service Level Investments in Routes 74, 153, 183 and 930
- Routing and trip changes to Routes 101 & 102 in Renton
- Discontinuation of Route 99

Target Service Level Improvements

Ordinance Proposal

- Route 74: Improve service to every 30 minutes mid-day weekdays on portion of the route between Sand Point and the University District
- Route 153: Provide weekday service every 30 minutes midday
- Route 183: Improve weekday service to every 30 minutes mid-day, add weekday service every 60 minutes at night
- Route 183: Provide weekday service every 30 minutes until
 9:30 a.m. and beginning at 2:15 p.m.


Routes 101/102

Ordinance Proposal

Route 102: Operate 8 additional peak period trips (5 morning and 3 evening) on portion of Route 102 between the South Renton Park & Ride and Seattle

Complementary Administrative Service Changes

Route 101: Revise Route 101 to layover at the South Renton Park & Ride instead of the Renton Transit Center



Route 99

Ordinance Proposal

 Discontinue route due to construction of Center City Connector streetcar, Alaskan Way Viaduct mitigation, and other waterfront projects

Route 99 Alternatives

- Add a new pair of bus stops on Route 29 on Broad St at 1st Ave northbound and on 2nd Ave southbound
- Alternatives connecting
 Pioneer Square and
 Belltown include Routes 1,
 19, 24 and 29
- Other alternatives include routes operating on 3rd Ave
