WHEREAS, the Washington State Republican Central Committee has submitted 17 the names of three constitutionally qualified candidates to fill the vacancy created by 18 Representative Koster's resignation, and 19 WHEREAS, to obtain information from the candidates about their qualifications 20 and views each county legislative authority has either interviewed them or provided them 21 with a written questionnaire; 22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED AND RESOLVED by the King County 23 council, the Board of Skagit County Commissioners and the Snohomish County Council: 24 A. Carolyn L. Eslick, one of the three nominees, is hereby appointed to the 25 position of state representative for the 39st legislative district in the Washington state 26 27 House of Representatives and continuing until a successor is elected at the next general election, and has qualified. 28 B. The clerks of the councils and board shall provide a copy of this joint motion 29 and resolution to the clerk of the Washington state House of Representatives, the 30
