22. Reports on Special and Outside Committees

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Councilmember Upthegrove reported on the Sound Transit Capital Committee meeting. The committee approved a contract to implement a portion of the Cascade High Speed rail program and a cost reimbursement agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for preliminary design services to extend a passenger platform as part of the Tacoma Trestle Track and Signal Project, The Committee also approved an update to the bus storage schedule to allow a permanent midday storage facility for up to 30 buses, approval of a contract for final design services for the South Bellevue to Overlake Transit Center segment of the East Link Extension, and amended a contract with Seattle Tunnel and Rail Team to provide additional construction management services for the University Link Extension.

Councilmember Lambert reported on the NACO Cyber Security Conference. Attendees included the Department of Justice, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Army, the Homeland Security and the Department of Defense. The conference covered the roles of each government entity regarding cyber security nationally and the importance of preparedness. Homeland Security is sending charts to help King County prepare for Cyber Security Awareness Month in October.
