1. Call to Order

4. Paul Brodeur, Director, Marine Division

Paul Brodeur, Director, Marine Division, reported on the ridership statistics for the Vashon and West Seattle routes. Mr. Brodeur also reported on the status of the new vessels construction, inclduing a visit by the Chair to the construction facility.

5. Horace Francis, District Accountant

Horace Francis, District accountant, reported on the June 2014 financial statement. John Resha, District staff answered questions of the committee. Mr. Francis also reported on the state audit of the District for 2013, including the federal grant compliance (A-133), financial and performance audits.
