4. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>

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Councilmember Upthegrove moved approval of the minutes of the April 27, 2016 meeting. Seeing no objections, the minutes were approved.

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5. Proposed Ordinance No. 2016-0107

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the executive to enter into an interlocal cooperation agreement with the city of Seattle, A Regional Coalition for Housing for the Eastside of King County, which may also include either or both Snohomish county and Pierce county, to invest and participate in a transit-oriented regional equitable development initiative fund.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the best starts for kids youth and family homelessness prevention initiative implementation plan.

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Mary Bourguignon, Council Staff, briefed the committee and answered questions from the members. Scarlett Aldebot-Green, Council Staff, also answered questions from the members. Adrienne Quinn, Director, Department of Community and Human Services, also answered questions from the members. Councilmember Lambert moved striking amendment S2. Councilmember Lambert moved amendment 1 to S2. Councilmember Gossett offered an oral amendment to amendment 1 to S2: on line 6, delete the word "may" and insert the word "shall". The Chair accepted the amendment as friendly. Amendment 1 to S2 passed unanimously. Councilmember Lambert moved amendment 2 to S2. The amendment failed by a vote of two ayes, two noes (Gossett and Lambert). Councilmember Lambert moved amendment 3 to S2. The amendment failed by a vote of two ayes, two noes (Kohl-Welles and Upthegrove). Councilmember Lambert moved for reconsideration of amendment 2 to S2. After reconsideration, amendment 2 passed unanimously. S2, as amended, passed unanimously.
