AN ORDINANCE approving and adopting a memorandum of agreement negotiated by and between King County and the King County Coalition of Labor Unions, establishing a "Total Compensation" package for King County employees for 2017 and 2018, which includes general wage adjustments, paid insurance benefits and a timeline for bargaining a "Master Labor Agreement" that will reflect standardized labor agreement provisions; representing employees in the departments of adult and juvenile detention, community and human services, elections, executive services, judicial administration, information technology, natural resources and parks, permitting and environmental review, public defense, public health and transportation and the assessor, council, district court, superior court, sheriff's office and office of the prosecuting attorney; and establishing the effective date of said agreement.

#### 15. <u>Reports on Special and Outside Committees</u>

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Councilmember Kohl-Welles gave a report on the Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC). She indicated that President John Marchione presented a Puget Sound

Regional Council Vision 2040 Award for the SR-520 Bridge Replacement project. Also, Josh Brown, Executive Director, announced that the PSRC is updating their State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) procedures. The Executive Board authorized a change in Transportation 2040 Project Status and TIP Programming for WSDOT's I-405 Corridor: Renton to Bellevue project. The Executive Board adopted the new 2017-2020 Regional Transportation Improvement Prorgram.

Councilmember Kohl-Welles also made comments about the 4Culture Board and its community funding recommendations.

#### **Other Business**

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Councilmember Lambert requested that the record reflect that she has on several occasions extended an invitation to Mr. Tsimerman to meet and discuss his relevant matters. At this time, he has not requested an appointment.

The Chair stated that Mr. Tsimerman has disrupted these proceedings and has not complied with the council rules.
