John Taylor, Interim Division Director, Water and Land Resources Division (WLRD), reported that there is a landslide warning due to saturated soil. WLRD is moving on forward on filling the FTE's authorized by the budget and is addressing space needs as new employees are hired. Mr. Taylor also indicated that the department has an Interlocal Agreement with the city of Pacific to expand sandbag distribution and briefed the committee on a public meeting regarding Cloud Creek affected property owners.
