A MOTION acknowledging receipt of a report related to the status of applications for the youth sports and facilities grant program and a recommendation on match requirements identified in Motion 13763.

WHEREAS, the youth sports facilities grant program has been funded through a sales and use tax on rental vehicles in King County, as well as from investment income on an endowment established with the proceeds from the sale of stadium properties, and

WHEREAS, since 1993, the youth sports facilities grant program has issued more than three hundred grants with funded projects including ball fields, sport courts, climbing walls, playgrounds, rowing facilities, skate parks, mountain biking courses, gymnasiums, swimming pools and weight rooms, and

WHEREAS, Motion 13763 states that the executive shall transmit a motion and report to the council regarding the status of applications to this program by September 15, 2014, and

WHEREAS, the parks and recreation division of the department of natural resources and parks reviewed the required local match issues identified in Motion 13763, and

WHEREAS, the executive has transmitted to the council the requested report and a motion;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
