negotiated by and between King County and Washington State Council of County

and City Employees, Council 2, Local 1652R (Industrial and Hazardous Waste)

representing employees in the department of natural resources and parks; and

establishing the effective date of said agreement.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The collective bargaining agreement negotiated by and between King County and

Washington State Council of County and City Employees, Council 2, Local 1652R (Industrial and Hazardous Waste) representing employees in the department of natural resources and parks, which is Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved and adopted by this reference made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Terms and conditions of said agreement shall be effective from January 1, 2015, through and including December 31, 2016.
