SECTION 1. The collective bargaining agreement negotiated by and between King County and

Professional and Technical Employees, Local 17 (Transit Administrative Support) representing employees in

the department of transportation,

which is Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved and adopted by this reference made a part hereof.
