WHEREAS, the 2017-2018 Biennial Budget Ordinance, Ordinance 18409, Section 21, Proviso P2, of this appropriation, \$1,183,000 shall not be expended or encumbered until the sheriff transmits a motion and response regarding the proposed cloud-based records management system project, and

WHEREAS, the attached response includes an assurance letter from the county's chief information officer and the director of the office of performance strategy and budget, which is Attachment A to this motion, and

WHEREAS, the response includes a benefits achievement plan which is Attachment B, a cost-benefit analysis which is Attachment C, a business case which is Attachment D and a project plan which includes the pilot of the project an updated project plan with a projection for the total of all capital and operating costs

associated with the selected cloud-based records management system solution project, which is Attachment E to this motion, and
