BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 18634, Section 1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

The county assessor of King County has certified to the metropolitan King County council that the assessed valuation of the County of King as finally equalized amounts to \$((532,856,899,490)) 532,657,126,307.
