AN ORDINANCE approving and adopting five memoranda of agreement regarding a freeze to step, longevity and merit increases negotiated by and between King County and Professional and Technical Employees, Local 17 (Departments: Public Health, Community and Human Services) [060]; Washington State Council of County and City Employees, Council 2, Local 21HD (Department of Public Health) [070]; Washington State Council of County and City Employees, Council 2, Local 1652 (Medical Examiner - Department of Public Health) [260]; Washington State Nurses Association (Staff Nurses -Departments: Public Health, Adult and Juvenile Detention (Juvenile Detention))) [310] and Washington State Nurses Association (Supervisors and Managers -Department of Public Health) [320] representing employees in the department of public health; and establishing the effective date of said agreements.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The five memoranda of agreement regarding a freeze to step, longevity and merit increases negotiated by and between King County and Professional and Technical Employees, Local 17 (Departments: Public Health, Community and Human Services) [060]; Washington State Council of County and City Employees, Council 2, Local 21HD (Department of Public Health) [070]; Washington State Council of County and City Employees, Council 2, Local 1652 (Medical Examiner - Department of Public Health) [260]; Washington State Nurses Association (Staff Nurses - Departments: Public Health, Adult and Juvenile

Detention (Juvenile Detention)) [310] and Washington State Nurses Association (Supervisors and Managers -Department of Public Health) [320] representing employees in the department of public health, which consists of Attachments A, B, C, D and E to this ordinance, are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. Terms and conditions of said agreements shall be effective from January 1, 2015, through and including December 31, 2016.
