1 AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of  
2 \$8,680,000 to the solid waste construction fund to purchase  
3 the Fisher Flour Mill property on Harbor Island; requiring  
4 the council to obtain an additional independent, third party  
5 review of competitive alternatives to the intermodal rail  
6 facility initially proposed by the executive; and amending  
7 the 2003 Budget Ordinance, Ordinance 14517, Section 118  
8 and Attachment B, as amended.

11 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:**

12 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation  
13 of \$8,680,000 to the solid waste construction fund for the purpose of purchasing the  
14 Fisher Flour Mill property on Harbor Island.

15 SECTION 2. Ordinance 14517, Section 118, as amended, is hereby amended by  
16 adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

19           SECTION 3. As a matter of policy, King County supports a strategic approach  
20 that fosters competition for waste disposal service. The council shall obtain an  
21 additional independent, third-party review of competitive alternatives to the intermodal  
22 rail facility initially proposed by the executive, with service options including, but not  
23 limited to:

24           A. Contracting with a locally owned, intermodal rail facility operator providing  
25 transportation services for commodities independent of the major waste hauling and  
26 disposal firms;

27           B. Contracting with existing municipal operators presently exporting wastes from  
28 the central Puget Sound region;

29           C. Contracting with municipal entities in eastern Washington to provide direct  
30 disposal services for King County waste; and

31           D. Contracting with major waste hauling and disposal firms capable of providing  
32 waste export service.

33           SECTION 4. In the event that King County decides not to develop a solid waste  
34 intermodal facility on the Fisher Flour Mill property on Harbor Island then disposition as  
35 surplus to county need shall be through competitive sale on the open market.

36                    SECTION 5. Attachment I to this ordinance hereby amends Ordinance 14517,  
37 Attachment B, as amended.




