2 On page 2, at the end of line 37, insert:

3 "Any agreement reached as a result of negotiations by the county sheriff or the county
4 executive with employees of the department of public safety shall not have the force of
5 law unless enacted by ordinance."

6 **EFFECT: Makes clear that collective bargaining agreements negotiated by the**
7 **Sheriff, like those negotiated by the Executive, will be subject to Council review and**
8 **approval.**

1 AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2010-0396, VERSION 1

2 On page 3, beginning on line 46, insert:

3 "SECTION 4. Within ninety days after certification that the charter amendment
4 in section 2 of this ordinance has been approved by the voters, the county executive and
5 the county sheriff shall submit to the county council a joint proposal for legislation
6 establishing a process of consultation and collaboration between the executive and the
7 sheriff in advance of collective bargaining negotiations concerning employees of the
8 department of public safety. The process shall be designed to promote successful
9 implementation of the charter amendment by identifying and resolving any disagreements
10 between the county executive and the county sheriff concerning the division of
11 bargaining authority, the positions to be taken on issues expected to arise during
12 collective bargaining or other matters that have the potential to interfere with collective
13 bargaining. The process shall provide that the county executive and the county sheriff
14 shall promptly submit a confidential, detailed, written report to the chair of the county
15 council and the chair of the council's labor policy committee describing any such
16 disagreement that the executive and the sheriff are unable to resolve. The process shall
17 further provide that neither the county executive nor the county sheriff shall propose or

18 agree to the inclusion of language in any collective bargaining agreement concerning
19 employees of the department of public safety without conferring with one another, except
20 in regards to compensation and benefits."

21 **EFFECT: If the charter amendment set forth in Section 2 of the ordinance is**
22 **approved by the voters, this amendment would require the Executive and the**
23 **Sheriff to submit a joint proposal to the Council for legislation to facilitate**
24 **implementation of the charter amendment in the manner described in the**
25 **amendment.**

1 **TITLE AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2009-0396, VERSION 1**

2 On page 1, delete lines 1 through 8, and insert:

3 "AN ORDINANCE proposing to amend Section 890 of the
4 King County Charter and to add a new Section 897 of the
5 King County Charter, to designate the county sheriff as the
6 county's bargaining agent on all department of public safety
7 issues except for compensation and benefits; submitting the
8 same to the voters of the county for their ratification or
9 rejection at the November 2010 general election; and
10 requiring the Executive and the Sheriff to submit a joint
11 proposal to the Council for legislation to facilitate
12 implementation of the charter amendment if it is approved
13 by the voters."

14 **EFFECT: (1) Changes the title to conform to Amendment 3. (2) Corrects the year in**
15 **which the proposed charter amendment will be placed on the ballot**
