10           WHEREAS, in Ordinance 15453, the King County council established a new  
11           citizens' elections oversight committee and adopted criteria for membership on the  
12           committee;

13           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


14           The reappointment of AJ Culver to the King County citizens' elections oversight
