2 court's assistance in conducting a weighted caseload analysis 3 of King County district court. 4 5 6 WHEREAS, annexations, incorporations, and establishment of municipal courts 7 within King County have affected district court judicial workload since the state 8 legislature established the number of district court judges for King County at twenty-six 9 in 1992, and 10 WHEREAS, RCW 3.34.020 authorizes county legislative authorities to request 11 the assistance of the Washington state supreme court to direct the administrator for state 12 courts to conduct a weighted caseload analysis as the first step of a process to decide 13 whether the number of judicial positions in a county should be changed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
