4 **EFFECT: The revised version of the Energy Plan does the following:**

- 5 • **Restructures the plan so that there are clear objectives and detailed**
- 6 **strategies to meet each objective**
- 7 • **Adds strategies related to achieving fleet efficiency and increasing ridership**
- 8 **on public transit**
- 9 • **Includes an increased emphasis on the importance of the county being a**
- 10 **leader in early adoption and promotion of innovative technology for**
- 11 **buildings and vehicles**
- 12 • **Expands the discussion on the benefits to the county of procuring and**
- 13 **producing renewable energy**
- 14 • **Adds a requirement to report back to the Council annually on progress in**
- 15 **implementing the strategies set forth in the Energy Plan**
- 16 • **Adds a strategy addressing ways to improve the energy efficiency of our**
- 17 **existing buildings, including to the extent practical, energy saving and**

18 **efficiency enhancing methods and specific measures informed by the *LEED***
19 ***for Existing Buildings: Operations and Maintenance***

- 20 • **Adds a commitment to account for energy savings and emissions reductions**
21 **associated with increased transit use by the community**
- 22 • **Adds a specific objective to pursue sustainable funding strategies for energy**
23 **efficiency, renewable energy projects, and GHG reduction efforts**
- 24 • **Adds a reference to the Environmental Protection Agency’s Energy Star**
25 **Portfolio Manager to benchmark county building performance as**
26 **appropriate, in particular for buildings located in Seattle, where periodic**
27 **energy benchmarking will become mandatory in 2011**
