7	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:	
8	SECTION 1. Findings:	
9	A. The city of Federal Way, Washington, by Resolution No. 04-424, has	
10	determined that it is in the public interest and general welfare to provide for the	
11	annexation of an area known as the Parkway annexation area, in accordance with chapter	٢.
12	35A.14 RCW.	
13	B. City of Federal Way Resolution No. 04-424 satisfies the provisions of chapter	<u>.</u>
14	35A.14 RCW for qualification for annexation.	
15	C. The city of Federal Way, by Resolution No. 04-424, initiated the annexation	
16	of the Parkway annexation area. KING COUNTY RECORD AND LICENSING S	S, ELEC ERVICE

17	D. The King County boundary review board received a request for review under
18	chapter 36.93 RCW, and on August 23, 2004, the review board, in file 2177, deemed the
19	proposed city of Federal Way Parkway annexation file approved.
20	E. Pursuant to chapters 29A.04 and 35A.14 RCW, the metropolitan King County
21 -	council deems an emergency exists for the purpose of calling a special election to be held
22	on the question of this annexation on November 2, 2004.
23	SECTION 2. A special election shall be held on the 2nd day of November 2004
24	in accordance with chapter 35A.14 RCW within the territory of the proposed annexation,
25	for the purpose of submitting the question of annexation of the Parkway annexation area.
26	SECTION 3. The number of registered voters within the subject area is estimated
27	at 589 as nearly as may be determined from available records.
28	SECTION 4. Pursuant to RCW 29A.04.321 and 35A.14.050, it is hereby deemed
29	that an emergency exists for purposes of calling a special election. The King County
30	director of the records, elections and licensing services division is hereby requested to
31	assume jurisdiction to call and conduct a special election and submit to the registered
32	voters within the subject area of the propositions as set forth in section 4 of this
33	ordinance. The clerk of the council is hereby authorized and directed to transmit these
34	propositions to the director of records and elections in substantially the following form,
35	with such additions, deletions or modifications in the ballot title as may be required for
36	the propositions listed below by the King County prosecutor:
37	PROPOSITION 1: The City Council of the City of Federal Way, Washington,
38	adopted Resolution No. 04-424 concerning a proposed annexation of the Parkway

annexation area. If approved, this proposition would annex an area of unincorporated

40	King County contiguous to the City of Federal Way's eastern boundary and commonly
41	known as the Parkway annexation area, which is legally described in City of Federal Way
42	Resolution No. 04-424. Upon annexation, the area shall have imposed the City of
43	Federal Way Comprehensive Plan designations and zoning classifications as adopted in
44	City of Federal Way Ordinance No. 04-460. Should this annexation and adoption of
45	proposed zoning regulation be approved?

49	PROPOSITION 2: Shall all property within the proposed Parkway annexation
50	area, upon annexation, be assessed and taxed at the same rate as property located within
51	the City of Federal Way is assessed and taxed to pay for all or any portion of the then
52	outstanding indebtedness of the City, which indebtedness has been approved by the
53	voters, contracted for, or incurred prior to, or existing at, the date of annexation?

56	SECTION 5. The boundaries of the territory proposed for annexation are hereby
57	described in city of Federal Way Resolution No. 04-424 as contained in Attachment A to
58	this ordinance.
59	SECTION 6. The council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists

and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
