1 AN ORDINANCE cancelling the April 26, 2011, special
2 election on the question of annexation of the city of
3 Enumclaw to the King County rural library district;
4 repealing Ordinance 17036, Section 1, Ordinance 17036,
5 Section 2, Ordinance 17036, Section 3, Ordinance 17036,
6 Section 4, Ordinance 17036, Section 5, Ordinance 17036,
7 Section 6, Ordinance 17036, Section 7, and Ordinance
8 17036, Section 8; and declaring an emergency.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

10 **SECTION 1. Findings:**

11 A. The city of Enumclaw, Washington, by Resolution No. 1406, determined that
12 it is in the public interest and general welfare to provide for the annexation of the city of
13 Enumclaw into the King County rural library and initiated the annexation into the library
14 district, and the metropolitan King County council enacted Ordinance 17036 as an
15 emergency ordinance so a special election could be held on the question of this
16 annexation on April 26, 2011.

17 B. At its March 7, 2011, council meeting the city council of Enumclaw adopted a
18 motion directing that its administration notify King County that the city withdrew from
19 the April 26 special election. The city council also directed the administration to draft a

20 resolution withdrawing from the April 26 election. On March 9, 2011, the city
21 administrator of the city of Enumclaw notified the clerk of the county council that the
22 city no longer wished to proceed with the special election on April 26, 2011. The city
23 council is scheduled at its meeting of March 14, 2011, to consider and adopt a resolution
24 withdrawing from the special election. Cancellation of the election requires immediate
25 enactment of this ordinance, repealing the ordinance that called for the election,
26 Ordinance 17036.

27 C. The deadline for notifying the department of elections of the cancellation of
28 the election was March 11, 2011. The council chair has provided informal notice to the
29 director of elections of the city of Enumclaw's desire to cancel the election. This
30 ordinance must be enacted as an emergency ordinance to ratify this notice.

31 SECTION 2. Ordinance 17036, Section 1, Ordinance 17036, Section 2,
32 Ordinance 17036, Section 3, Ordinance 17036, Section 4, Ordinance 17036, Section 5,
33 Ordinance 17036, Section 6, Ordinance 17036, Section 7, and Ordinance 17036, Section
34 8, are each hereby repealed.

35 SECTION 3. Effective date. This ordinance takes effect upon the adoption of a
36 resolution by the city of Enumclaw withdrawing from the April 26 election or requesting
37 cancellation of the April 26 special election on annexation into the King County rural
38 library district.


39 SECTION 4. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency
40 exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace,

41 health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public
42 institutions.

Ordinance 17048 was introduced on 3/14/2011 and passed as amended by the Metropolitan King County Council on 3/14/2011, by the following vote:


