7 County council that the assessed valuation of the County of King as finally equalized

8 amounts to ((~~\$386,495,592,582~~)) \$386,517,731,870.

9 **SECTION 2.** Ordinance 17954, Section 2, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10 The metropolitan King County council imposes the levies necessary to fund

11 estimated expenditures for the year 2015 as listed in this section. These amounts do not

12 include the total of estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including

13 available surplus and such expenditures as are to be net from bond warrant issues. In
