1 **STRIKING AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2016-0493, VERSION**

3 On page 1, beginning on line 8, strike everything through page 6, line 105, and insert:

4 "BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1. A. This ordinance proposes changes to the rates for county
6 employees at County automotive parking facilities and includes the King Street Center
7 into the County automotive parking facilities portfolio starting June 1, 2017.

8 B. These fees are assessed pursuant to K.C.C. 2.99.030.

9 SECTION 2. Section 3 of this ordinance takes effect June 1, 2017.

10 SECTION 3. Ordinance 15648, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.006 are
11 each hereby amended to read as follows:

12 The definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter unless the context
13 clearly requires otherwise.

14 A. "After hours parking" means work time parking for employees whose normal
15 work shifts begin after 1:30 p.m. and end between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. or who are
16 required to come into work after 4:30 p.m. "After hours parking" also includes parking
17 on weekends and holidays that is required by the employee's agency.

18 B. "Business convenience" means a county business-related requirement. For the
19 purposes of this chapter, "a county business-related requirement" includes after hours
20 parking for county employees, parking for commissioned sheriff's office personnel,
21 parking for county employees working for a specified and limited period on a time-
22 sensitive project that requires them to arrive before or stay after regular work hours,
23 parking for county employees who are required as part of their jobs to use their private
24 vehicles to routinely travel to multiple county business locations, and parking for county-
25 owned vehicles and paid parking for county volunteers authorized by ordinance or by any
26 presiding elected official as defined by K.C.C. 3.24.010 or the presiding elected official's
27 designee, but for the executive branch any designee must be at least the highest-ranking
28 employee of a division.

29 C. "County automotive parking facility" means:

- 30 1. The Goat Hill parking garage located at Sixth Avenue and Jefferson in Seattle;
- 31 2. The parking structure located at the regional justice center in Kent;
- 32 3. County adult detention center parking facilities located at Fifth Avenue and
33 James in Seattle;
- 34 4. Open surface lots that are owned or leased by the county; (~~and~~)
- 35 5. The Chinook Building parking located at Fifth-Avenue and Jefferson in
36 Seattle; and
- 37 6. The King Street Center, located at 201 South Jackson Street in Seattle.

38 D. "County volunteer" means a person who is not a county employee, who
39 performs service for the county for civic, charitable or humanitarian reasons, without
40 promise, expectation or receipt of compensation from the county for services rendered

41 and who is accepted as a volunteer by the county. "County volunteer" includes, but is not
42 limited to, a person serving as a board member, officer, commission member, volunteer
43 intern or direct service volunteer.

44 E. "Director" means the director of the county department of executive services
45 and his or her successor or designee, unless otherwise specified in this chapter.

46 F. "Public parking" means general purpose parking by persons who are not
47 county employees and by county employees that park for less than a full day.

48 SECTION 4. Sections 5 and 6 of this ordinance take effect January 1, 2017.

49 SECTION 5. Ordinance 8753, Section 6, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.045 are
50 each hereby amended as follows:

51 The rates for county employees parking at the Goat Hill parking garage shall be as
52 follows:

53 A. Daily parking for motorcycles: five dollars;

54 B. Hourly parking: Hourly public parking rates shall apply up to a maximum of
55 ~~((fifteen))~~ twenty dollars per day for automobiles; and

56 C. The rate for after-hours parking shall be seven dollars per day.

57 SECTION 6. Ordinance 12077, Section 18, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.055 are
58 each hereby amended to read as follows:

59 A. Monthly employee and county vehicle rates for parking in the Goat Hill
60 parking garage, the Chinook Building, the King County Correctional Facility and open
61 surface parking lots that are designated by rule to be subject to parking charges, shall be
62 as follows:

71 B. The facilities management division of the department of executive services
72 shall identify surface parking lots where it is reasonable and feasible to charge employees
73 for monthly parking. These surface parking lots are located at county facilities outside
74 the downtown Seattle metropolitan core and include, but are not limited to, district courts,
75 health centers, alcohol treatment facilities, police precincts, youth service centers and
76 similar facilities. Designation of open surface lots that are subject to parking charges
77 shall occur by administrative rule adopted pursuant to K.C.C. 3.32.010.

78 C. For county employees with disabilities that make it difficult or impossible to
79 use public transit, and who display a disabled parking permit, the fee for covered parking
80 in facilities managed by the facilities management division shall be fifty percent of the
81 monthly employee rate, rounding up to the next even dollar. Employees with disabilities
82 shall receive first priority in the assignment of available parking stalls.

83 SECTION 7. Section 8 and 9 of this ordinance takes effect June 1, 2017.

84 SECTION 8. Ordinance 8753, Section 6, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.045 are
85 each hereby amended as follows:

86 The rates for county employees parking at the Goat Hill and King Street Center
 87 parking garages shall be as follows:

88 A. Daily parking for motorcycles: five dollars;

89 B. Hourly parking: Hourly public parking rates shall apply up to a maximum of
 90 twenty dollars per day for automobiles; and

91 C. The rate for after-hours parking shall be seven dollars per day.

92 SECTION 9. Ordinance 12077, Section 18, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.055 are
 93 each hereby amended to read as follows:

94 A. Monthly employee and county vehicle rates for parking in the Goat Hill
 95 parking garage, the Chinook Building, the King County Correctional Facility, the King
 96 Street Center garage and open surface parking lots that are designated by rule to be
 97 subject to parking charges, shall be as follows:

106 B. The facilities management division of the department of executive services
 107 shall identify surface parking lots where it is reasonable and feasible to charge employees
 108 for monthly parking. These surface parking lots are located at county facilities outside

109 the downtown Seattle metropolitan core and include, but are not limited to, district courts,
110 health centers, alcohol treatment facilities, police precincts, youth service centers and
111 similar facilities. Designation of open surface lots that are subject to parking charges
112 shall occur by administrative rule adopted pursuant to K.C.C. 3.32.010.

113 C. For county employees with disabilities that make it difficult or impossible to
114 use public transit, and who display a disabled parking permit, the fee for covered parking
115 in facilities managed by the facilities management division shall be fifty percent of the
116 monthly employee rate, rounding up to the next even dollar. Employees with disabilities
117 shall receive first priority in the assignment of available parking stalls."
