SUBJECT:

A MOTION confirming the Executive's appointment of Linda Madsen, who resides in Council District Two, to the King County Mental Illness and Drug Dependency Oversight Committee.

SUMMARY:

The executive has forwarded for council consideration and approval the following appointment:

Proposed Motion 2011-0479: The Executive has appointed Linda Madsen to a partial term on the King County Mental Illness and Drug Dependency (MIDD) Oversight Committee, as a representative from the Community Health Council of Seattle and King County, expiring June 30, 2012. She received a master's of Social Work from the University of Washington. Ms. Madsen currently is a Healthcare Consultant with Community Health Council of Seattle and King County.

BACKGROUND:

The 30 member King County MIDD Oversight Committee (K.C.C. 2.130.010) is composed of separately elected officials and King County agency directors or designees along with representatives of providers of services to the mentally ill and drug dependent. The oversight committee is an advisory body to the council and executive. The committee reviews and comments on emerging and evolving priorities for the use of the mental illness and drug dependency sales tax revenue; promotes coordination and collaboration between entities involved with sales tax programs; educates the public, policymakers and stakeholders on sales tax funded programs; and coordinates and shares information with other related efforts and groups.
